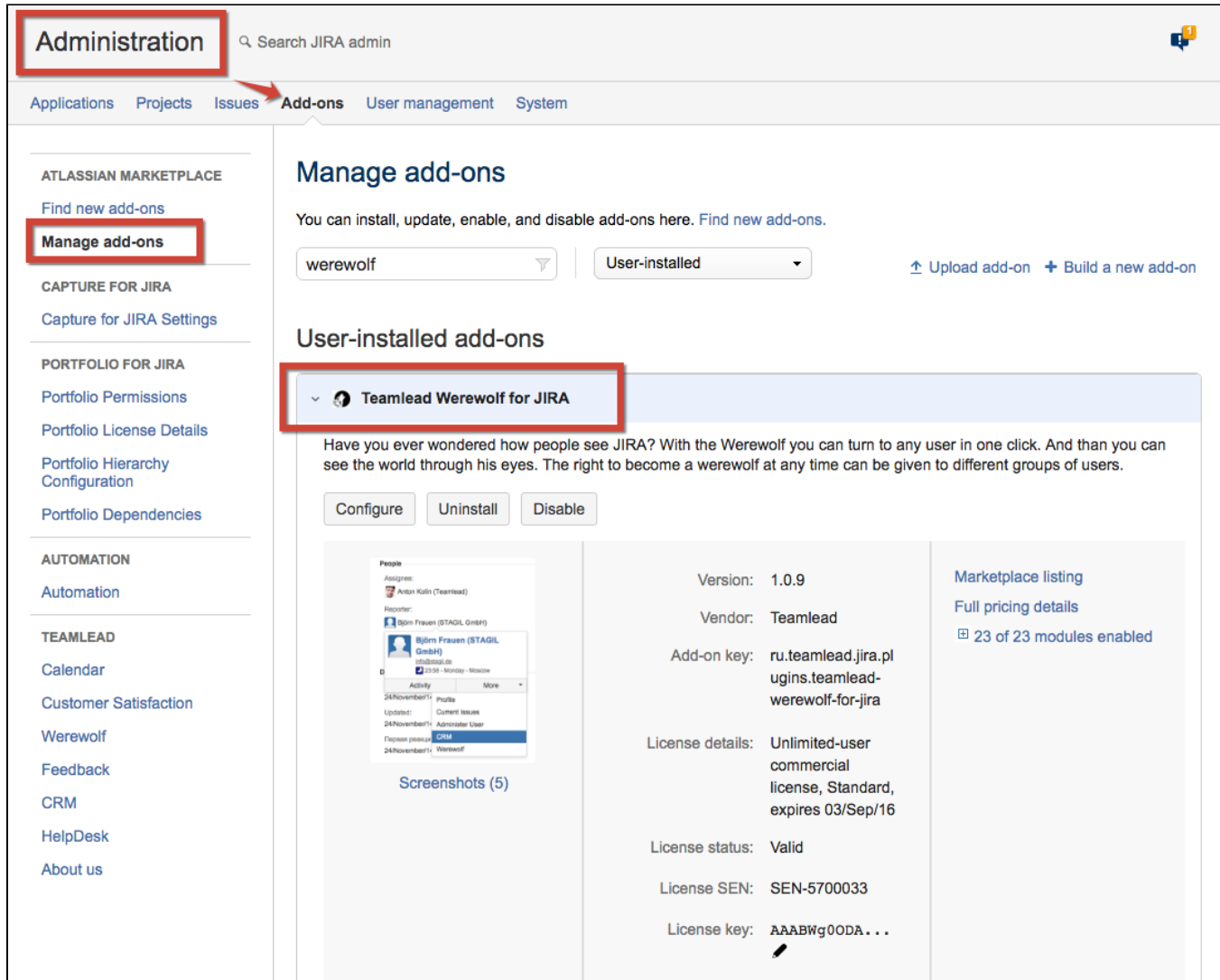


Werewolf for JIRA

Werewolf for JIRA is a common JIRA plugin. So it could be installed like the other plugin through Universal Plugin Manager.

To install the plugin you need to login to JIRA as an administrator, and in the Administration\ Add-ons\ Manage Add-ons find our plugin by name: Teamlead Werewolf for JIRA and install it.
