

# Set Assignee Function

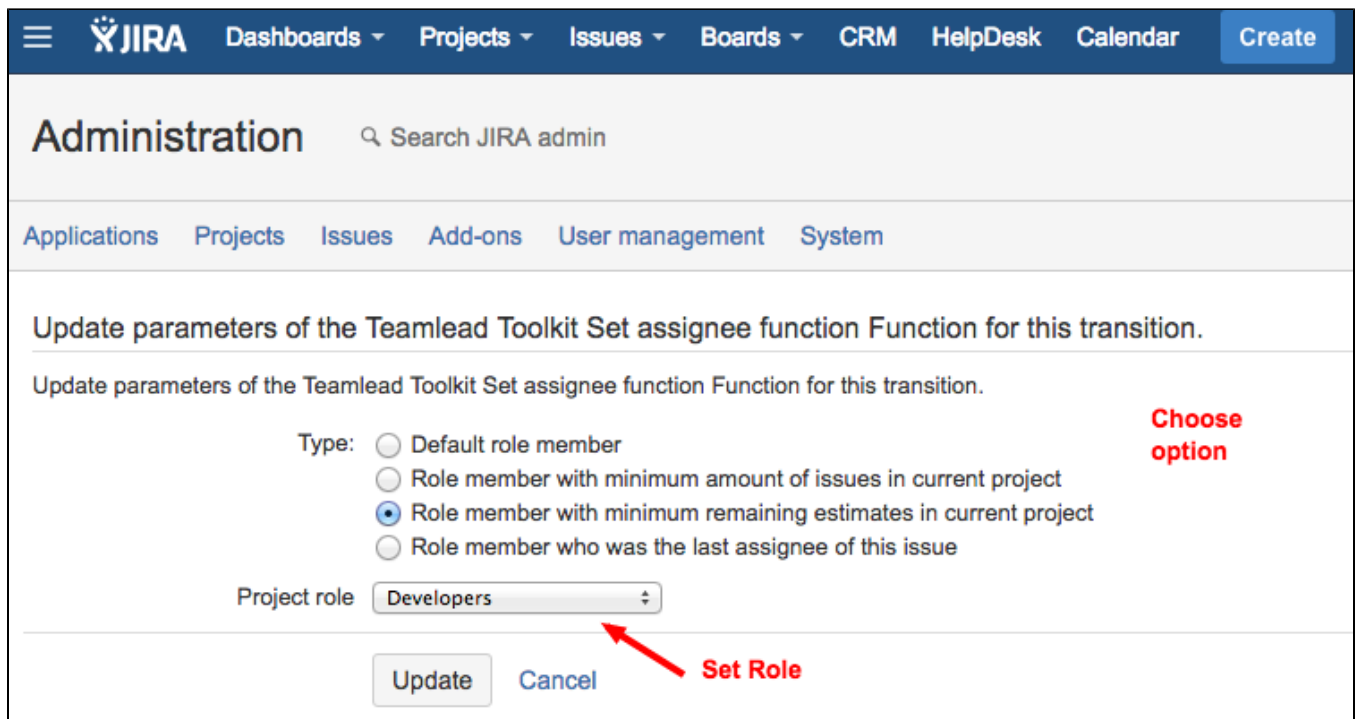
## Use:

This postfunction allows to set assignee from some project role. It may be:

- role member with minimum amount of issues in current project;
- role member with minimum remaining estimates in current project;
- role member who was the last assignee of this issue;
- default role member. Set user property to the user, who should be the default role member.

The name of the property is a role name. The value of the property is a code of the project, where the user should be a default role member. For example: **Property name = Developer** and **Property value = Dev**
